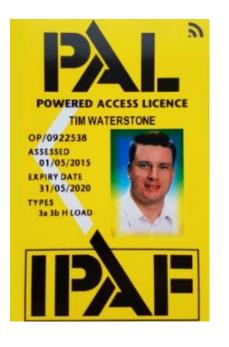

Practical tests for each category have a 2 year life	5 year life
Expectation to move to a blue card	Can be renewed



# Plant Training - terminology

- Categories
- Novice, refresher/experienced
- Tests practical and theory
- NPORS traditional and NPORS CSCS
- In-house training and cards
- VQs, onsite assessment, logbook, touchscreen test
- Multiple cards
- Multiple categories
- Advanced

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# **CITB** Plant Grant – Short Duration

Short Duration Training Grant	Theory Test	Practical Test	
£30-£120 (most plant sits at £120)	£60	£190, £240 or £410	
All plant training	CPCS only	CPCS only	
Achievement uploaded by employer or ATO	Automatic feed from CPCS – reg number to provider	Automatic feed from CPCS – reg number to provider

# **CITB Plant Grant - VQ**

**Plant VQ Achievement** 

Employers can apply for **£600** for each full VQ achievement, up to a maximum of four achievements at each level per individual.

Grant is **only paid once for a full Plant Operations VQ per individual**, but employers can apply for grant for other plant related VQs (such as Demolition) at levels 2, 3 and 4.

Within the maximum of four achievements at Level 2, an employer can apply for a maximum of **three plant related VQ units per individual at £300 each.** 

Where there is a previous grant for a plant operations VQ, future achievements will only be considered for the plant-related VQ unit grant.



# **CITB** Plant Grant

What does not attract grant?

Health, Safety and Environment Test

More than 2 practical tests per individual per year

Testing or training more than once on same category of plant (lifetime)

More than 4 VQ achievements per individual (lifetime)

CPCS Renewal Test (touch screen) for renewing the Blue Cards

Log book (Blue Card renewal)

On site assessment to prove ongoing practical experience (Blue Card renewal)

## CITB Plant Review - what we set out to achieve



- Short duration training standards
- New plant grants

- Standardise plant training
- Improve the quality of that training
- Encourage more training prior to testing
- Support employers to train new entrants



## **Training and Assessment Requirements**



- Minimum qualifications and experience for plant trainers and testers
- Separation of training and assessment
- Location of delivery
- Card schemes / providers can go above and beyond these minimum requirements

## Plant Grants – what's changing?



- Increase overall investment in plant grant
- Combine training and testing one standard, one grant
- Replace three grants practical test, theory test and short duration training – with one grant
- Introduce 6 new plant grant rates 3 novice, 3 experienced
- Initially 8 most common plant training standards

#### New Plant Grant Rates

## What will be grant eligible



Only training that fulfils all the below criteria:

- meets our new training standard
- is quality assured by the provider, the card scheme and CITB
- is delivered by an ATO approved scheme provider
- leads to a card carrying the CSCS logo.

## What will not be grant eligible



- Testing with no formal training beforehand
- Training that leads to an unsuccessful test
- Training which leads to a card that does not carry the CSCS logo or no card at all
- Training on a category if someone has already received CPCS test grant for it
- Training on a category where grant has already been paid out, even if at a different experience level
- Refreshers and renewals

# Why only CSCS cards?



- Aligns with CLC policy statement on one logo card being accepted on site
- Promotes the route to competence
- Provides an additional layer of assurance prompted by industry feedback

#### How will this first phase work



- 8 of the most commonly used plant standards:
- New rates
- New eligibility
- No employer manual upload option
- All other plant standards in terms of rates, eligibility and claim route unchanged....for now
- We will look at data and any fine tuning required
- All other plant standards will then be changed

## The first 8 standards



- Excavator 360, above 10 tonnes (tracked)
- Forward tipping dumper (wheeled)
- Rear tipping dumper/ dump truck: articulated chassis (all sizes)
- Ride on roller
- Telescopic handler: all sizes excluding 360 slew
- Industrial forklift
- Plant and vehicle marshaller
- Slinger, signaller: all types, all duties

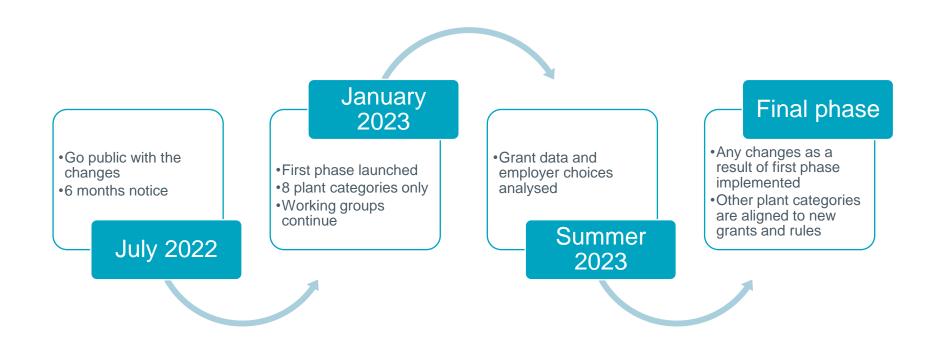

#### The timeline









- Through its new plant grants, CITB wants to encourage more people into the plant sector.
- We want plant training to be standardised, quality assured and transferable.
- CITB wants more people to undertake a recognised test at the end of that training, that gives them a card aligned to CLC policy and provides employers with the assurance they have a safe and competent workforce.
- We are not saying that people can't do a plant test without first attending formal training. However, we will no longer incentivise this through grants and funding.
